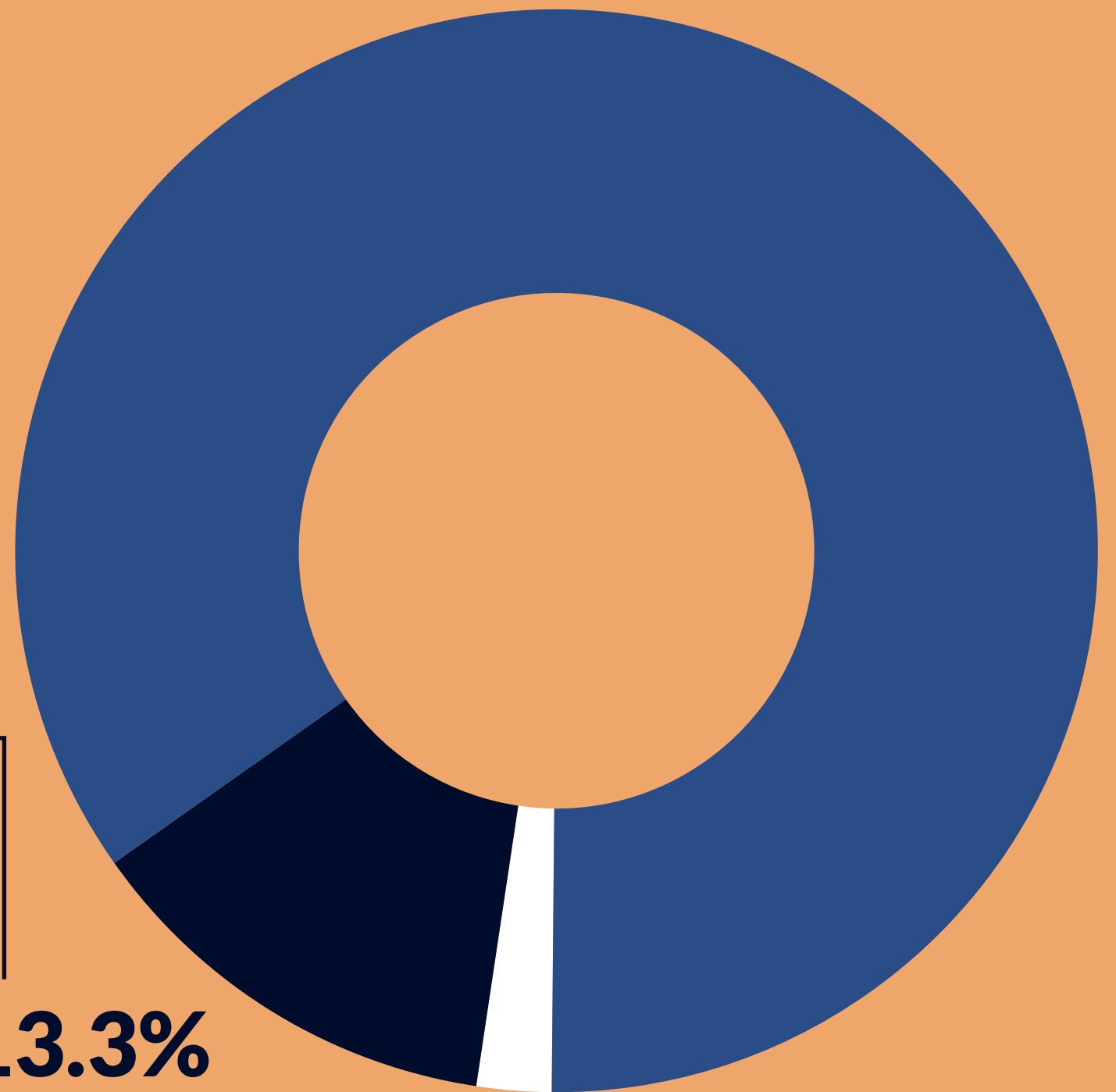

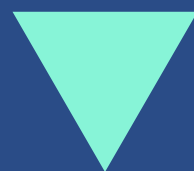
Private
